### Introduction and Recommendation

On May 18, 2022, I received an application (Exhibit A) for the restoration of 42 dangerous monuments located in Esperance Cemetery in the Village of Esperance, Schoharie County. This application was submitted by Kirtland Feuz, Trustee of Esperance Cemetery Association. Included is a letter from Linda Feuz, Secretary/Treasurer of Esperance Cemetery Association, stating that all of the monuments under application are very old and that the cemetery does not have any contact information for the lot owners. Based upon the information provided, it is the Division's understanding that the cemetery has determined that the lot owners cannot be found.

Included with this application is an estimate from Humphrey Memorials (Exhibit B) for \$69,650 for the repair of the hazardous monuments and foundation work. Also included is an estimate from McFee Memorials (Exhibit C) for \$104,936 for the repair of the hazardous monuments and foundation work. Also included is a copy of the required notice and bill for \$171.78 (Exhibit D).

### The Monuments

I visited the cemetery and found that all 42 monuments under application were either loose on their foundations or tipping and appeared to pose a hazard to cemetery visitors and employees. The cemetery has had no response to the legal advertisement which it placed, and has no funds dedicated to the restoration of monuments.



The Humphrey Memorials repair estimate (Exhibit B) proposes to remove, repair, and reset the monuments on new foundations and seal all joints. They offer a ten-year warranty. The McFee Memorials repair estimate (Exhibit C) proposes to remove, repair, and reset the monuments on new foundations. They offer a ten-year warranty.

### Recommendation

Esperance Cemetery Association is up to date with the filing of annual reports and vandalism and assessment fees. All papers are in order and this appears to be a legitimate claim for \$69,821.78


