January 22 & 26 Public Meetings at Brentwood Public Library to Solicit Community Input on New Brentwood Community Center

Governor Cuomo has announced \$15 million in capital funding to support the creation of a new community hub for recreational and educational, social services opportunities in Brentwood as part of an overall investment of more than \$45 million to combat gang violence on Long Island. The new Recreational Center will serve as a one-stop shop for community-based organizations to provide area youth, including more than 19,000 students in the Brentwood School District, with year-round recreational, health, and educational opportunities.

The Brentwood Recreational Center Planning Committee, co-chaired by Suffolk County Executive Steve Bellone, Town of Islip Supervisor Angie Carpenter and New York Secretary of State Rossana Rosado, invite members of the Brentwood community to participate in two public meetings to be held on Tuesday, January 22 and Saturday, January 26.

The meetings present the opportunity for members of the public to provide input on the types of services and programming that should be offered at the new Community Center. We invite all members of the public to attend these meetings and provide their input.
