STATEWIDE--PURSUANT to 15 CFR 923.84(b), the New York State Department of State (DOS) hereby gives notice that the federal Office of Ocean and Coastal Resource Management (OCRM) concurred on June 25, 1987 with DOS on one routine program implementation action. The action is the incorporation of the City of Ogdensburg Local Waterfront Revitalization Program into New York State's Coastal Management Program (CMP). DOS requested OCRM's concurrence on May 8, 1985 for the City of Ogdensburg in a previous notice in the *State Register* which further describe the content of the implementation action.

Pursuant to the State CMP and Article 42 of the NYS Executive Law the NYS Secretary of State approved [redacted] LWRP on March 27, 1987.
