Introduction and Recommendation

The Division received an application (Exhibit A) for the repair of 70 hazardous monuments located in the Forest Lawn Cemetery of the City of Buffalo, Erie County. The application was submitted by Joseph Dispenza, President of the Forest Lawn Cemetery Association. Included with this application was an estimate, from Western New York Cemetery Services (Exhibit B) totaling \$66,110, and an estimate from Forest Lawn Cemetery (Exhibit C) for \$83,061. Also included was an invoice from the AmPol Eagle legal notices (Exhibit D) that were run for three consecutive weeks for \$225.00.

I recommend approval of this application.

The Monuments

Investigator Craig visited the cemetery on May 7, 2020 and found that all 70 the monuments were either loose on their foundations or tipping and appeared to pose a hazard to cemetery visitors and employees. The cemetery has had no response to the legal advertisement which it placed, and has no funds dedicated to the restoration of monuments.

Both estimates propose to: remove the monuments from the existing foundations; dig out the existing foundation; place a new foundation made of solid concrete poured to a depth of 42 inches; and replace the monument, resealing all joints with setting compound or epoxy and offers a twenty-year warranty.

The Estimates

The cemetery has provided a bid for these repairs, has stated that they are fully capable of performing all work and are bidding the foundations at their approved rate. Western New York Cemetery Services has provided the low bid and is owned by close relatives of Craig Wolcott, a Forest Lawn employee.

I spoke to Craig Wolcott of Forest Lawn and he stated that he did not discuss this project with any non-cemetery personnel. He further stated that the estimate provided by Forest Lawn was higher than the other bid due to the state approved foundation charge and the fact that the cemetery employees are paid union scale.

The average low bid for the last ten applications approved in the western New York region was \$1,085 and the average high bid was \$1,279 per monument. The average price bid by Western New York Cemetery Services for this application is \$944 and the average price bid by Forest Lawn Cemetery is \$1,187. The bid price appears to be in line with other applications approved by the Board.

Recommendation

The cemetery is current with its payments to the vandalism fund and with the filing of its annual reports. This appears to be a legitimate claim for \$66,335. I recommend that this application be approved.
