Introduction and Recommendation

I received an application (Exhibit A) for the repair of 54 hazardous monuments located in the Resthaven Cemetery of the town of Phelps, Ontario County. The application was submitted by Mark Falkey, president of the Resthaven Cemetery Association. Included with this application was an estimate from Senecal Memorials (Exhibit B) totaling \$92,234 and an estimate from D A Memorials (Exhibit C) totaling \$101,500. Also included was an invoice from a legal notice (Exhibit D) that was run for three consecutive weeks in The Finger Lakes Times. I recommend approval of this application.

The Monuments

I visited the cemetery on January 14, 2022 and found that 45 of the monuments were either loose on their foundations or tipping and appeared to pose a hazard to cemetery visitors and employees. I noted that : #18 Dunkenfield, #22 Holmes, #29 Kenous and #54 Shear monuments appeared to be solid when inspected, Mr. Falkey agreed with my observation and these monuments were removed from consideration. I also noted that the #13, Selleck, #33 Allen, #39 Hough, #44 White and #48 Green monuments appeared to have been down for a long time and then stood back up recently in an unsafe manner. Mr. Falkey stated that a group of people had erected these stones over the summer and that the cemetery would take responsibility for making these monuments secure, as such, these monuments were removed from consideration and both estimates were adjusted. Mr. Falkey stated that the cemetery does not have records for these very old monuments, the most recent of which is dated 1905. The cemetery has posted a legal advertisement in an attempt to locate lot owners, the final date for

response to this notice is February 18, 2022. Based upon the information provided, it is the Division's understanding that the cemetery has determined that the monument owners cannot be found. The cemetery has no funds dedicated to the restoration of monuments. Based on the advanced age of the monuments in question, it is assumed the foundations were laid privately by either the families or by monument contractors.

The Estimates

Senecal proposes to: remove the monuments from the existing foundations; dig out 40 existing foundations; place 40 new foundations made of solid concrete poured to a depth of 42 inches and replace the monument, resealing all joints with setting compound or epoxy and offer a 20 year warranty. DA is the higher bid and did not provide foundation depth or warranty information.

Recommendation

The cemetery is current with its payments to the vandalism fund and with the filing of its annual reports. All documents appear to be in order, and the previous allocation was used properly, there has been no response to the legal notice that was posted to date. This appears to be a legitimate claim for \$77,625.40. I recommend that this application be approved.

Michael,

I went to the Cremetery and inspected all monuments in this proposal. The 5 in question of laying flat and in a safe condition and recently set up to make them unsafe # 13 Charles Selleck, #33 Robert Allen, #39 Justas Hough #44 Jessie White and #48 John Green we have determined a group of people doing volunteer work in the cemetery last summer changed the position of the stones. This group stood up several stones in an attempt to repair them. We do not believe cemetery officials or contractors touched these stones at all. Our cemetery will take responsibility to make these stones safe and pay for any expenses.

The 4 monuments in question of being already safe #18 Dukenfield family stone, #22 John Holmes, #29 Abram Kanous and #54 Shear family stone have been determined to be safe by us. I contacted both contractors and they agree they had to push very hard on them to get any movement. We agree with your decision.

As for the new requirement for legal notice. I have contacted our secretary . We have no records for addresses of family or lot owners of any of these monuments in this proposal. The newest monument in this proposal is #32 Rev. Joseph DeLarme in the year 1905. Our cemetery did not start recording family - lot owner addresses until the 1980s about the time I started on the board of directors.

Mark,

I visited the cemetery and looked at the stones and found that 45 of them appear to be eligible.

I noted that:

- #13, Charles Selleck
- #33 Robert Allen
- #39 Justas Hough
- #48 John Green

are all stones that had been laying on the ground for some time (in a safe position) and have been recently set up (in an unsafe position). If the cemetery set these monuments up, the cemetery is responsible for the unsafe position and as such they are responsible for paying to make them safe. If they were set up by family members, then they are responsible for paying to make them safe.

Please provide a statement regarding how these stones came to be upright after being in the ground for so many years.

I also noted that: #22 John Holmes

#18 Dunkenfield

#29 Abraham Kanus

#54 Shear

All appear to be straight, level and solid, as such they do not appear to pose a hazard, if you have some information that I am missing, please provide a statement as to why you feel these monuments are a hazard. Feel free to reach out to your contractors if they have some technical data that would illustrate the hazard.

Also, the #44 Jessie White monument appeared to have been down for years, then set up, then fallen down again, as it is down, it will not be included.

Lastly, we have a new requirement for the legal notice. It has been determined that the cemetery must check their records for last known addresses of the lot owners for each monument listed and if there is contact info, send them a certified letter explaining that they are responsible for repairs. If after checking the cemetery records it is determined that no such records exist, the cemetery may then post the legal notice (as you have done) . Please check your records and send out letters or notify me that you have no such records and why, also give me a statement of the date of the newest monument you have listed on the application to illustrate the age of the monuments (and records) in question.

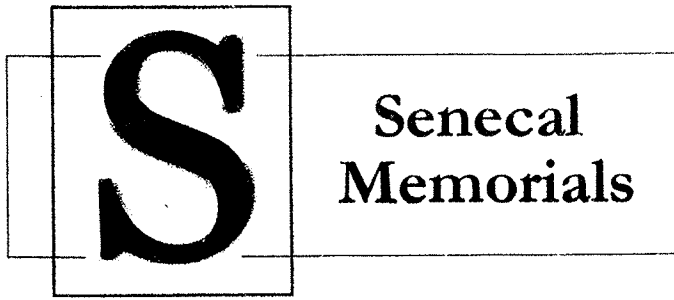

Senecal Memorials will supply suitable equipment and manual labor to remove each monument and to place in a safe location while work is being done. We will remove each old foundation and truck debris away for disposal. We will dig new foundations to appropriate size, set forms to a depth of 42" and stated dimension for each. We will finish concrete to a smooth surface and seal with appropriate sealer. We will reset each monument with new setting compound and silicone sealer if necessary where seam will not allow compound. We will back fill with topsoil, rake and seed as necessary.

Warranty

Senecal Memorials will warranty the workmanship of the foundations for a period of fifty years from the date of completion. Senecal Memorials will warranty for 20 years the resetting of all the monuments removed to install new foundations. This warranty will consist of every layer of the monument removed and reinstalled with setting compound and/or epoxy. This warranty does not cover any part of the stone that could not be removed due to large pinning of the original setting. This warranty also does not cover incidental breakage or chipping of monuments due to their age and/or nature of the difficulty to remove some of the layers. This being said, Senecal Memorials will do everything within our control to remove and replace all monuments in a manner that would preserve their appearance and safety for many years to come.




