Introduction and Recommendation

The Division received an application (Exhibit A) for the repair of 105 hazardous monuments located in the Lennox Rural Cemetery, town of Lennox, Madison County. The application was submitted by Larry Ball, secretary/ treasurer of the Lennox Rural Cemetery Association. Included with this application was an estimate, from Pexton Memorials (Exhibit B) totaling \$51,308 and a letter from Kellogg Memorials (Exhibit C) declining to submit a bid. Also included was an invoice from The Oneida Daily Dispatch for a legal notice that was run for three consecutive weeks.

I recommend approval of this application.

The Monuments

The Lennox Rural Cemetery was visited, and 105 monuments were found to be either loose on their foundations or tipping and appeared to pose a hazard to cemetery visitors and employees. Mr. Ball stated that the cemetery has no records for the monuments in question and as such, could not contact the last known lot owners by mail, the most recent monument is dated 1922. The cemetery has had no response to the legal advertisements which it placed, and has no funds dedicated to the restoration of monuments. Based upon the information provided, it is the Division's understanding that the cemetery has determined that the monument owners cannot be found.

The Estimates

Pexton Memorials proposes to: remove the monuments from the existing foundations; dig out existing foundations; place new foundations made of solid concrete poured to a depth of 42-48 inches and replace the monument, resealing all joints with setting compound or epoxy and offer a five-year warranty. The estimate averages \$489 per monument, which is below average for the last ten applications approved by the Board. This is because 15 monuments will be reattached and sealed on the existing foundations.

Mr. Ball requested a second estimate from Kellogg Memorials and received a letter declining to bid, citing: "so much work and we are backed up".

Recommendation

The Cemetery is up to date on annual reports and vandalism payments. This appears to be a legitimate claim for \$51,353.75. I recommend that this application be approved.
