

Mandatory COVID-19 Precaution Checklist

Written License Exam Candidates:

- Do not appear for an exam if under the current Department of Health guidelines, you are required to isolate or quarantine. You may view the most recent guidelines on the Department of Health's website at: <https://coronavirus.health.ny.gov/isolation-quarantine>

- Do not appear for an exam if you are currently experiencing or have recently (within the past 48 hours) experienced ANY of the following symptoms of COVID-19:
 - Fever or chills
 - Cough (new or worsening)
 - Shortness of Breath or difficulty breathing (new or worsening)
 - Muscle Pain or Body Aches (new or worsening)
 - Headache (new or worsening)
 - New Loss of Taste or Smell
 - Sore Throat (new or worsening)
 - Congestion or Runny Nose
 - Nausea or Vomiting
 - Diarrhea

Note: A few of the above symptoms may occur with pre-existing medical conditions such as allergies or migraines. You should not appear to your exam if your symptoms are new or worsening. If you are experiencing symptoms, you should contact your health care provider or seek diagnostic testing for COVID-19.

- Bring two #2 pencils to your exam.
