RE: VANDALISM, ABANDONMENT AND MONUMENT REPAIR OR  
REMOVAL FUND: APPROPRIATION AND ANTICIPATED  
PAYMENTS IN  
FY 2025-26

DATE: March 10, 2026

The following is a brief summary of collected fees and payments of funds granted from the Vandalism, Abandonment and Monument Repair or Removal Fund. The vast majority of monies are collected concurrent with the submission of annual reports, generally filed within the first three months of the calendar year.

For calendar year 2026, the vandalism collections are \$104,564.00 and the assessment collections are \$52,280.00. Fiscal year collections from April 1, 2025, are \$137,106.00 for vandalism and \$63,873.00 for assessments.

The appropriation for the 2025-2026 fiscal year is \$2,000,000.

There are applications that the Cemetery Board approved in previous years that we have not paid in full yet, either because the cemeteries have not completed the work or for other reasons. There remains \$17,930.39 of funds committed for 2019/20 applications, and \$47,613.60 committed for applications approved in the 2020/21 fiscal year. There are no outstanding payments for the 2021/22 fiscal year. Outstanding payments for the 2022/23 fiscal year totals \$24,463.44. Outstanding payments for applications approved in the 2023/24 fiscal year total \$66,424.93. \$71,249.57 is still

owed on applications for fiscal year 2024/25. \$908,805.44 is still owed on the 43 applications approved so far, this fiscal year (2025/26).

Currently there are 12 applications in the pipeline for approval seeking a total of \$536,940.82. There are five applications on the agenda for this meeting totaling \$321,914.42.
